

Agreement between Lewis Shickluna
of the Town of Saint Catharines, and M. W.
& E. Browne of the Town of Hamilton
both places, Canada West.

That the aforesaid Lewis Shickluna
is to build a Schooner length of Keel to
be One Hundred and ten feet, the
remainder to be, as laid down in the
Estimate which will be signed by
both parties, a copy to be made out
and signed as above so that each party
may always have a reference to the
agreement. — For and in consider-
ation of the building the above
mentioned Schooner the aforesaid
M. W. & E. Browne is to pay the
aforesaid Lewis Shickluna the
sum of Two Thousand One Hundred
Pounds Halifax Currency, to be
paid as follows.

Four Hundred pounds to be
paid now out of his store.

Two Schooners the Kent and Telegraph,
for and in consideration of Seven
Hundred pounds, the above
schooners to be delivered to the said
Lewis Shickluna at St. Catharines
in the fall of this year one Thousand
Eight Hundred and forty five,
