In response to these pressing and urgent financial shortfalls, Brock University has created the **COVID-19 Undergraduate Student Emergency Bursary** and the **COVID-19 Graduate Student Emergency Bursary** to provide emergency financial relief to these students.

The Student Emergency Bursaries have been established with funding from the Office of the President, Office of the Provost, Office of the Vice-President, Research, the Brock University Students' Union and the Graduate Students' Association. The bursaries will be used to provide emergency financial aid for both graduate and undergraduate students and will be available to help students in need.
